Having been led by the Spirit of God to receive Jesus Christ as Lord and to live my life according to Biblical truth, I enter into this covenant with the Pioneer Family Academy as a paid employee. I understand that this covenant is a reflection of and expansion of the Pioneer Family Academy Statement of Faith. By signing below I agree to abide by the principles and requirements expressed in both documents.

- 1. Biblical Standards:
 - I will live by the Biblical standards as expressed in 1 Corinthians 6:9-11; Titus 2:5-9; Hebrews 13:4.
 - I will express biblical doctrine of Pioneer Family Academy and not become a participant in known cults.
- 2. Sexual Purity:
 - I will not live or participate in any homosexual or lesbian affairs.
 - I will not pursue, participate or live in conjugal relationship with the opposite sex, outside of marriage.
 - I will not become or cause pregnancy in an unmarried relationship.
 - I will not have any involvement with pedophile perversion.
 - I will not use pornography, including Internet use.

The employee agrees to biblical standards of sexual purity, which calls for every believer in Jesus Christ to maintain sexual relations only within a marriage of one man to one woman. Any sexual activity or relationship outside of the marriage relationship stated above is subject to the immediate termination of the employee.

- 3. Substance Abuse:
 - I will not be a user of any illegal drugs or substances.
 - I will abstain from excessive alcohol use and refrain from public consumption of alcohol that may cause another to stumble.
- 4. Staff/Student Conduct:
 - I will avoid any appearance of evil (1Thessalonians 5:22). I will not allow my own reputation or that of PFA to be hurt in any way as a result of my behavior with students at PFA. I will at all times avoid:
 - Being alone with a student and I will not violate the "Two-Deep" leadership policy
 - > Touching a child in an inappropriate or rough manner
 - > Talking to a child in an inappropriate manner
- 4. Personal Commitment:
 - 1. To maintain a clean, neat and modest (non-revealing, non-suggestive) appearance, at all times, according to the dress code outlined in the PFA handbook.
 - 2. To endeavor to present a loving and servant attitude to members of the staff/body at all times.
 - 3. To endeavor to strengthen my relationship with Jesus each day by endeavoring to pray and read His word.
 - 4. To maintain personal integrity in all interactions with members of the staff and the body.
